By the year 1789, William Dunlap owned 401 Acres and 31 perches.

Poland Presbyterian Church, - The congregation was organized May 3, 1802, by Rev. William Wick, pastor of the congregations of Youngstown and Hopewell, and a member of the Erie prebytery. William Dunlap was one of the organizing members.

William Dunlap paid \$.80 tax in 1803 while living in Poland, Ohio.

In a DAR application, it has that William was born in Colerain Twp., Chester Co., PA; now Lancaster County. Lancaster was divided off from Chester County in an act of May 10, 1729. So if he was born in Colerain Township, he was born in Chester County, Pennsylvania.

William was granted a pension dated 1 Aug 1833. He was a revolutionary soldier.

Dunlap - Liberty Tp., June 11, 1835

"Mr. Wm. Dunlap, a soldier of the Revolution at 82 yrs. He was one of the first settlers of this county. He left a numerous offspring and it is some what remarkable that all of his children, ten in number, though heads of families were present at his funeral."

Date of application for pension Aug 21, 1832, his claim was allowed. Resident at date of application was Weathersfield, Trumbull Co., OH.

He died at the home of his daughter and son-in-law, Simon Peter Carlton, Liberty Twp., Trumbull County.

His will is dated 3 Jun 1830. Probate record book 8, p 49. It was probated on 30 Jun 1835.

William came to America with his father's family when about four years of age (although, his revolutionary war record states he was born in Chester county, Pennsilvania). There is difference of opinion in regard to where the first settlement was made. Some sying it was in Canninsberg, Washington County, Pennsylvania and others in Colerain, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. We know little of William's father. His occupation was tanning and it is said that he lived to the advanced age of 104 years, also, his teeth were wonderfully preserved through his long life. He retaining them all at his death. William was a soldier in the Revolutionary War. He entered the army when residing in Colerain, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, serving three different periods of time. Dates of Length of Rank Captain Colonal State Enlistment Service Aug. 1776 2 months Sgt. James Ross Robert Thompson Penns 1777 3 months Lieut. Robt Miller Greenawalt Penns 1778 2 months Lieut. Robt Miller Greenawalt Penns He participated in the battles of Brandywine and Germantown in 1777, he being at the time about 24 years of age (rank of Sergeant). In regard to the portion of his life previous to this we are almost entirely in ignorance. When young he was instructed in the same branch of business that his father had been in although farming became his chief occupation. After Williams service in the Continental army he settled in Bucks County, Pennsylvania and was soon afterwards married to Miss Margarett Bronn, to whom it is said he was engaged seven years previous to their marriage. They first went to housekeeping in Bucks County where they remained until about the year 1782. They were parents of 10 children, John, James, William II, Andrew, Margaret, Josiah, Elizabeth, Mary, Samuel, and Hannah. From Bucks County they removed to Washington County, Pennsylvania where they remained probably about eighteen years. Their children all being born there except the two oldest. Their next removal was to Poland, Ohio in about the year 1800. William bought two hundred arces of land about where the village of Poland now stands, built a house there and resided there about two years. He then exchanged his two hundred acres of land in Poland, Ohio for seven hundred acres in Weathersfield, Trumbull County, Ohio where he spent the remainder of his days. He lived on his farm in Weathersfield until after the marriage of all his children. He then divided his property among his children and he and his life companion lived in a small house on his son William's farm and near by his house. They remained there until the death of his wife which occurred November 28, 1830 and for some time afterwards William lived there alone, but finally removed to Simon Peter Carlton's, his grandson, about two years before his death. He had a paralalytic stroke when about 40 years of age from which he never fully recovered. This was followed by another in his old age which proved fatal. He was struck speechless while sitting in his chair about eleven days before his death which occurred in June 1836. He being 83 years old. In regard to the personal appearance of William Dunlap; it is said he was a medium sized man, thick-set, muscular and robust, of a dark

complexion with black hair and black eyes and possessed a rather pecular organism which was transmitted to several subsequent generations. He was a member of the Baptist Church known as the old regular Baptist. Politically speaking he was an Anti-Jackson man, belonging to the Clay school of politics. He was of a mild and sociable disposition. He was also very fond of books and had an uncommon inclination to read especially in his declining years and he was very fond of coffee, it being requested at every meal. Worshiple Master of Brooks Lodge No. 47.

The DUNLAP FAMILY, of which William Dunlap, Sr., was the first representative in Trumbull county, were among the earliest settlers here. William Dunlap, Sr., emigrated from Washington county, Pennsylvania, to Poland township, then Trumbull county, Ohio, about 1800. He afterwards purchased seven hundred acres of land in Weathersfield, and moved to that township about 1806. His sons settled around him on this tract. He had a family of six sons and four daughters. He died in Liberty township at the residence of his daughter, Mrs. Carlton, at the age of about ninety-six. His son William married Rachel Frazee, of Poland, and lived on the farm, which is now occupied by the widow of the late Stephen Dunlap, son of William, Jr. William and Rachel Dunlap were the parents of nine children, of whom three are yet living, to-wit: Rachel (Lewis) and Perry in Lordstown, and Chauncy in Vienna. Stephen Dunlap was born November 30, 1813, in Weathersfield, on the farm, where he lived until his death December 18, 1881. He married in 1840 Hannah McMullen, of Brookfield, who was born in 1822. Mrs. Dunlap still resides on the old Dunlap homestead. She has three children, as follows: George in Wisconsin, B. F. in New York city, and Emma at home.

Notes from the Dunlap -Grace M. Winnagle Collection: John was rather a large man, robust and of a dark complexion. He was a member of the Presbyterian Church. He had 56 grand children and quite a number of great grand children.

John, the oldest child of William and Margaret Dunlap was born in Bucks County, PA, Nov 10, 1780, moved from Bucks County with his fathers family to Washington Co. PA and then to Poland, Ohio. On Nov 19, 1802 he was married to Prudence McConnel. They had eleven children. The fourth died while quite young and his name is unknown. John Dunlap moved from Poland, Ohio to Weathersfield, then to Bristol, Trumbull county, Ohio where he died March, 1859. Aged 79 years. He had 56 grand children and several great grand children. His wife died Oct. 7, 1857 at Farmongton, Ohio. They were Presbyterians.

William Dunlap was a man about six feet tall weighing about 180 pounds. He was of dark complexion and grey eyes. Rachel was a medium sized woman rather fleshy with black hair and black eyes. She lived to be 81 years of age.

He was a large fleshy man of dark complexion. He was of a very sociable disposition and a jolly companion. He was a member of the Presbyterian Huch. He lived to be 78 years of age. He not only lived to raise his children but also to bury all but one.
